

Whiskey Facts

- This Kentucky Bourbon pays tribute to the earliest days of our distillery's history, when in 1939 we released our first Bottled-in-Bond.
- Aged for seven years, this Bourbon exceeds the exacting standards set forth in the Bottled-in-Bond Act of 1897.
- Heaven Hill Distillery is extremely selective when crafting this Bourbon, waiting until just the right barrels have matured.

Tasting Notes

Color: Golden amber

Aroma: Warm notes of vanilla, honey, and a

rich caramel sweetness

Taste: Smooth, warm and sweet with a

subtle rye spice note; caramel and honey mingle with just enough oak and char to round out the richness

Finish: Long, lingering





RITTENHOUSE RYE

Style: Rye Whiskey

Proof: 100

Whiskey Facts

- This award-winning Rye Whiskey has a storied past that celebrates Philadelphia's famous Rittenhouse Square.
- In the early 2000s, craft bartenders revived cocktail culture with the help of this historic brand.
- Made with 51% rye for a distinct, spicy flavor that stands up when mixed in cocktails.

Tasting Notes

Color: Mahogany


Aroma: Dried fruits, toffee, and sweet peppers

Faste: Clean, rich, cocoa, citrus, cinnamon,

nutmeg and vanilla

Finish: Lingering maple-like spiciness





OLD FITZGERALD

Style: Wheated Bourbon

Proof: 100

Whiskey Facts

- This legendary line is well-known for its distilling pedigree and intriguing story behind its namesake, John E. Fitzgerald.
- The bottle and packaging was inspired by the original 1950s Old Fitzgerald diamond decanter.
- The label features the time-honored graphic of a key, commemorating an important element in the original label artwork.

8-Year-Old Tasting Notes

Color: Bright burnished copper

Nose: Brown sugar and toasted bread; notes of cinnamon and nutmeg

Palate: Peaches and cream with peppery

spice and caramel sweetness

Finish: Spice notes linger alongside peach,

pear and caramelized brown sugar





MELLOW CORN

Style: Corn Whiskey

Proof: 100

Whiskey Facts

- This corn whiskey is distilled from a mash of at least 80% corn and aged for four years in a once-used Bourbon barrel.
- Aging in a used barrel gives the spirit a lighter straw color instead of the deep amber created by newly charred oak barrels.
- Heaven Hill Distillery is one of the few remaining producers of this unique style.

Tasting Notes

Color: Pale straw

Aroma: Oak and delicate spice

Taste: Full-bodied and textured,

with a softly spiced sweetness

Finish: Sweet and chewy like a Barbadian Rum
